Accessibility

Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

- Entities subject to Title II will be required to conform their digital content to the WCAG 2.1 Level AA, a set of guidelines and criteria for making web content more accessible to a wider range of people with disabilities.
- A public entity with a total population of 50,000 or more shall begin complying with this rule **April 24, 2026.**

VITA Governance

- Web System Standard has been updated to reflect WCAG 2.1.
- Siteimprove site targets have been updated to WCAG 2.1 Level AA.

Exception for Documents

- Created before 4/24/26
- Is not altered or updated
- Is not used to access or participate in public services, programs, or activities.




Scores / Site Targets

Target = accessibility score if you reach

100 in the listed areas

- Site Targets are generally in the low- to mid-90s, higher than the current benchmark of 81+.
- An accessibility score of 100
 requires meeting all Siteimprove
 rules (Level AAA, best practices)





Dashboards

- Pre-canned reports and views to highlight important information in one place
- Several VITA-created dashboards available now.
- Agencies can create their own as well!

Fusion (JAWS + ZoomText)

JAWS (Job Access With Speech) is a computer screen reader program developed for computer users whose vision loss
prevents them from seeing screen content or navigating with a mouse. Fusion couples the JAWS software with ZoomText,
screen magnification and visual enhancement software. Learn more about <u>Fusion</u>.

JAWS Inspect

 Screen reader testing tool that vastly simplifies accessibility and JAWS® compatibility testing by providing a text output of JAWS speech. Learn more about <u>JAWS Inspect</u>.

Google reCAPTCHA Enterprise

• Captcha is required for all public applications and eforms. VITA has procured access to Enterprise reCAPTCHA for agencies that do not have a captcha solution already in place on their web systems. Learn more about <u>Google reCAPTCHA</u>.

Architecture Review Process

Purpose

• The EA225 web systems standard requires architecture review for web systems prior to their **initial release**, and on subsequent release of **architecturally significant changes**.

Requirements

Measure	Approved!	Approved with Exceptions	Denied with Exceptions
Accessibility Score	> 81%	80% — 50%	< 50%
Critical/High Defects	0		Any
Branding Bar	✓		×
Domain Naming	✓	*	
Performance Score	> 90%	90% — 60%	< 60%
